TALLINN OPEN INTERNATIONAL WRESTLING TRAINING CAMP: The TALLINN OPEN training camp (March 30 – April 1, 2026) is a Unique high-level training opportunity which takes place immediatley following the tournament at the competition site. The motto is „adding something new to your style“.

The 2025 Camp was attended by 754 GR, FS and WFS wrestlers of Schoolboy/girl, Cadet and Junior age from 21-countries. With such a wide diversity of wrestlers, the camp emphasises sparring, to maximise experience from different schools of wrestling to help you add to your „own wrestling style“. This is a vetted camp (not for beginners) and the number of participants is limited.

Training and Coaching is led by various participating and special coaches. In 2025, Yui SUSAKI led the women's training. For 2026 we plan to again have accomplished World renowned coaches.

Overview:

- Camp is March 30 – April 1, 2026 on 16-mats, at the Competition Site.
- Two sessions per day
- Saunas and shower facilities present
- Cost of camp is 27eur/day. This includes 2-training sessions, facilities and two post-training meals.
- Free transportation is provided by the City of Tallin during the competition and training camp

KRISTJAN PALUSALU

Kristjan Palusalu is Estonia's most famous sports person, having won the Heavyweight Gold Medal at the 1936 Berlin Olympics in both Greco-Roman and Freestyle. Kristjan remains the only person to ever have achieved this feat at the same Olympic Games. Young wrestlers have the opportunity to duplicate this feat, by participating in both Greco-Roman and Freestyle days.

In 2025 – three wrestlers accomplished this feat!

The **TALLINN OPEN** organising committee, is please to invite you to Europe's largest wrestling tournament, the 2026 TALLINN OPEN – KRISTJAN PALUSALU YOUTH WRESTLING TOURNAMENT in GR, FS, WFS and WGR, from 26–29 march, 2026. The tournament is on 16-mats and employs the Nordic A/B system which guarantees a two match minimum. It is possible to wrestle both GR (WGR) and FS (WFS) on subsequent days. TALLINN OPEN is for experienced wrestlers and is limited to 2500 wrestlers.

The **2025 TALLINN OPEN** was attended by 2537 wrestlers (including 485 women) from 39-countries. Many National Teams use Tallinn Open for preparation or as a benchmark qualification tournament for European (Continental) and World Championships. The 2025 tournament attracted over 40 national teams of various age-groups in GR & FS and WFS & WGR. The 2023 protocol is here: www.liga-db.de/classic/TallinnOpen2025

TALLINN OPEN is immediately followed by the International Wrestling Training Camp from March 30 – April 1, 2025. The 2025 training camp attracted 754 GR, FS and WW wrestlers from 30-countries (please see Training Camp on page 4).

UNIBET ARENA Paldiski Maantee 104B, Tallinn 13522 www.unibetarena.ee (GPS coordinates: Lat: 59°42.6156', Long E 24° 64.7332'). UNIBET ARENA is 10km from the Airport and Harbour, and 7km from the centre of the Old City.

REGISTRATION:

ATHLETE NAME ; ATHLETE WEIGHT (we understand that this may change over coming months) ; WRESTLING STLYE (GR and/or FS & WFS and/or WGR); NAME OF TEAM; COUNTRY; Do they participate in training camp (if so , which days). Registration starts 1. september 2025.

Registration ends either March 20, 2025 OR at 2500 registered wrestlers, whichever comes first.

NOTE: In 2025, registration was closed 5-weeks before start of competition, since maximum number of participants was reached.

REFEREE: Experienced accredited referees are encouraged to participate. In 2025 there were 83 referees (including 33 UWW referees) from 16-countries. Referees are provided accomodations and meals and compensated:

- 150eur per day for International Category referees
- 100eur per day for National Category referees

Referees must be 21 years old

In the event of over registration , international category takes precedence. For information and to register as a referee, please forward credentials to info@tallinnopen.ee

PARTICIPATION FEES: Possibility to wrestle both GR & FS and WFS & WGR.

- 37 euro Greco-Roman OR Freestyle (both MEN and WOMEN). After 1-march participation is 45 euro.
- 45 euro Greco-Roman AND Freestyle (both MEN and WOMEN). After 1-march participation is 53 euro.
- An additional fee of 13 euro/wrestler is charged for those teams without a referee.

Over 350 teams from circa 40 countries are participating. To avoid onsite registration and payment delays – we strongly suggest pre-payment. Invoice will be provided. We understand that there may be last-minute lineup changes and guarantee any overpayment will be reimbursed. Thank-you.

The City of Tallinn provides **FREE** city-wide transportation on buses, trolleys and trams with a special QR code. The QR-code will be available March-1, 2026 . Taxi from harbour and airport to competition site is about 8-10 EUR. **Bolt** and **Uber** also operate in Tallinn.
